

Access a Virtual Machine using Omnissa Horizon Client

UAS virtual machines can be accessed by active UAS Students and Employees by installing Omnissa Horizon Client.

- 1. In a browser, navigate to https://mydesktop.uas.alaska.edu
- 2. Select the Horizon Client for Windows link
- 3. Scroll down to Omnissa Horizon Clients and select View Download Components
