## UAS HOUSING POLICY BASICS:

To ensure a smooth and enjoyable living experience for all, residents should familiarize themselves with UAS Housing policies. Below are some highlights:

- **Alcohol** – Residents aged 21+ may possess and consume alcohol in apartments/suites where at least one resident of legal drinking age resides. However, it must not be accessible to individuals under 21. Alcohol should be stored in private bedrooms, not common areas. A unit with at least one legal drinker may possess up to 60 beers or five 750 ml bottles of alcohol total (open or unopened)
- **Smoking** – All Student Housing is smoke- and tobacco-free, including vaping, cigarettes, and marijuana, due to federal regulations.
- **Animals** – Unauthorized pets are prohibited, even for brief periods of time. ESA owners cannot leave animals with roommates or in other units during absences.
- **Decorations** – Decorations must not block windows, curtains must be moveable, and lights/decorations cannot hang from ceilings. Roommate approval is required for common area decorations.
- **Guests** – Guests may stay no more than 10 nights per semester, no matter who their host might be. Hosts are responsible for guest behavior. Gatherings with 12+ people and alcohol require prior approval from Housing Staff.
